our home together

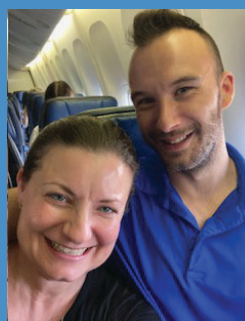
