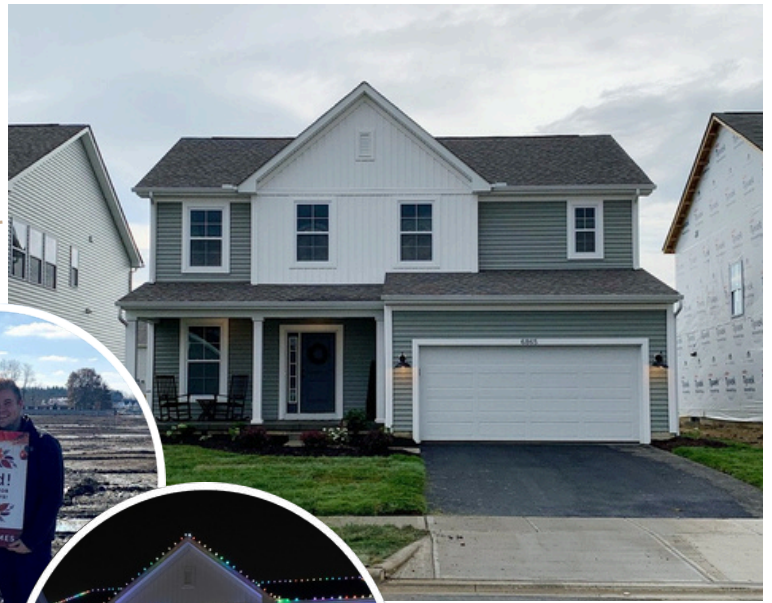
By Chase:
