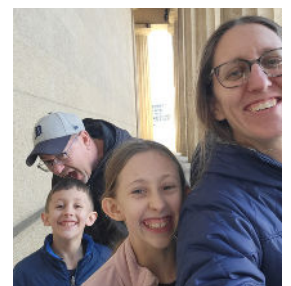
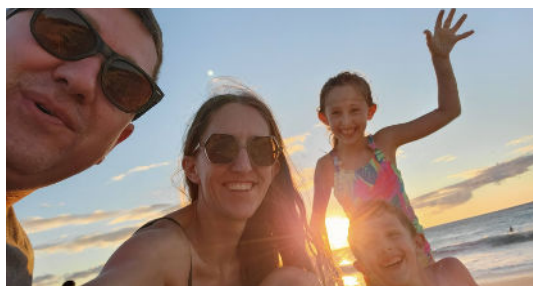
Micah works full time as a manager with a local utility company. His job is close by and they offer excellent time off so he can join in on day trips to the zoo or a local museum.
