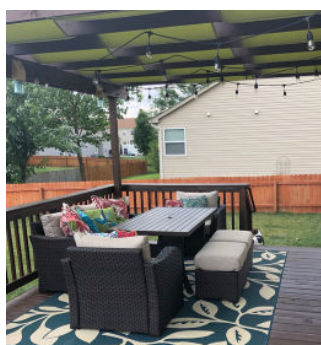
Nine years later, they've become the perfect pair; total opposites who balance each other out. They've definitely kept us on our toes over the years, but we wouldn't trade it for anything.
