LUIS

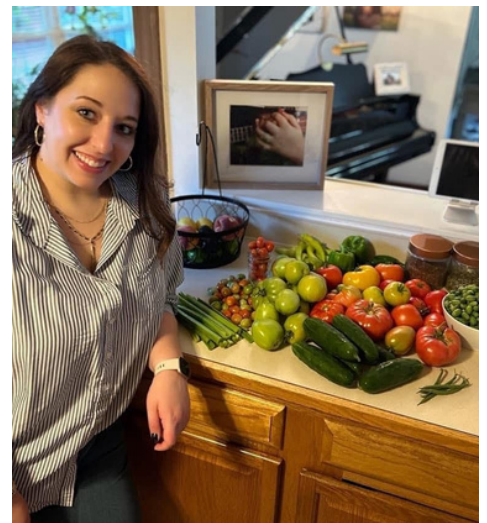
