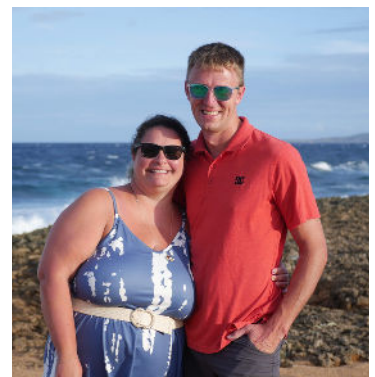
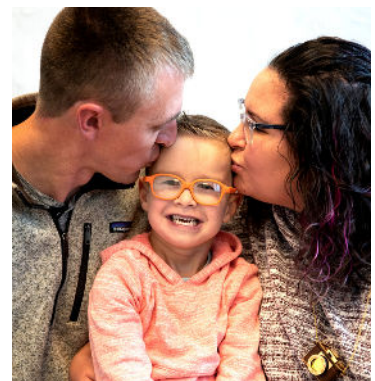


# About Us

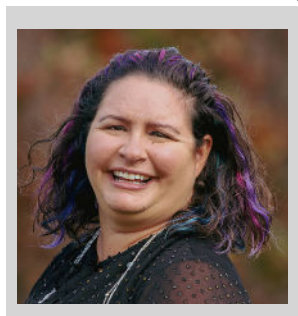

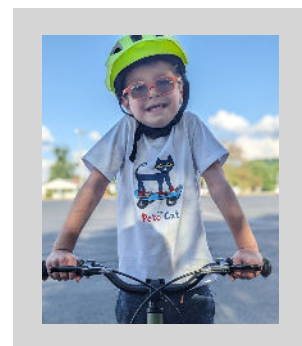

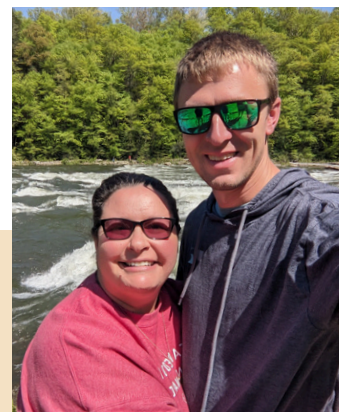


# Our Village
