

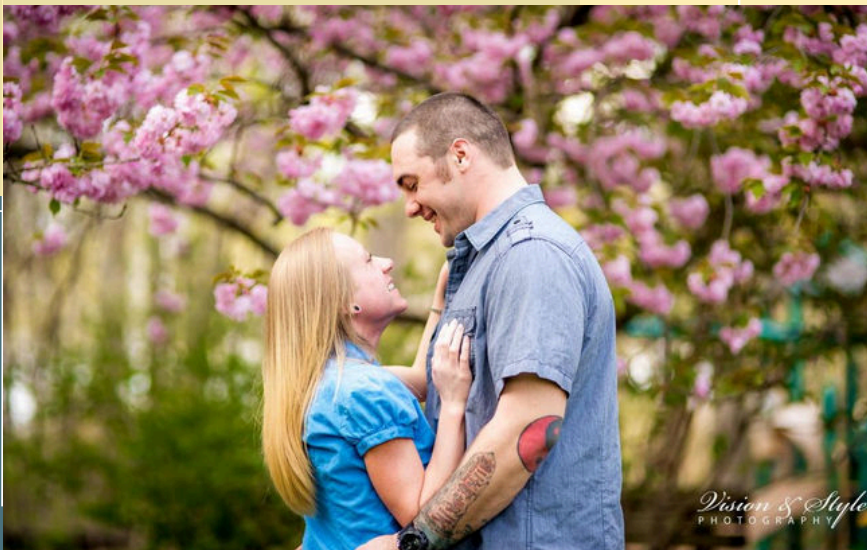
Jaime & Ed

Together, we are a couple who values love, laughter, and creating a nurturing home. We're excited to share our hearts and our life with a child who is ready to join our family.

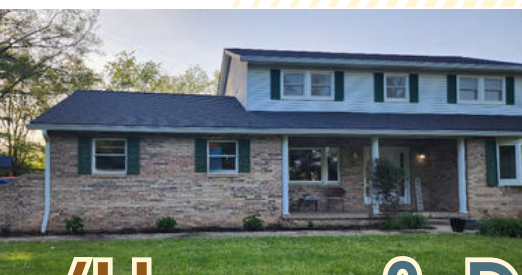
